**Subject: Special Project under SGSY for Placement Linked Skill Development in 14 States (Karnataka, AP, Orissa, Bihar, Haryana, Rajasthan, MP, Uttarakhand, Gujarat and Maharashtra by Ikya Human Capital Solutions Pvt. Ltd. (IKYAHCSPL)**

Reference is invited to NABCONS letter No. Nabcons/1727/IKYA/2010-11 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2011 on the subject mentioned above. The Project Approval Committee (PAC) for Special Projects under SGSY considered the proposal in its meeting held on 16.3.2011 and approved the project subject to following conditions and modifications:

1. The project will cover 8,000 rural BPL beneficiaries in the proposed States.
2. The total project cost will be Rs. 1483.12 lakh. MoRD funding would be Rs. 1112.34 lakh. IA will contribute Rs. 370.78 lakh (25%) in the project cost. Per beneficiary subsidy will be Rs. 13904/- including monitoring fee @ 1.5% and Rs. 2000 per beneficiary for post placement support payable to the beneficiaries @ Rs.1000 per month.
3. The States of TN, Kerala, Pondicherry & West Bengal will be excluded or replaced with other States and beneficiary coverage adjusted accordingly
4. Audit Reports of the project should reflect the total Govt. grant (Central & State Share and interest thereon) and cash contribution if any from other sources with reference to cost estimates & components in the project report. In case of contribution in kind by Implementing Agency or other sources, the Auditor will provide a separate certificate indicating the valuation of cost components borne by IA or other sources. The Audited accounts, however, need not reflect this as part of receipts.
5. No stipend will be paid to the beneficiaries, during the training period out of funds provided by MoRD under this project.
6. The implementing agency will furnish a certificate to the effect that the beneficiaries trained and /or placed have not been assisted under any other Government programmes for similar skill development/training.
7. No capital assets, equipment or infrastructure will be supported under the project with Government funding. Only expenses on consumables and apportioned revenue expenses (rental, lease etc.) on training related infrastructure will be permissible.
8. The implementing agency will furnish an affidavit to the effect that the infrastructure or cost components included in the project proposal have not been funded and not proposed for funding under any other government programmes/schemes. This is an essential condition for the release of funds by the coordinating agency i.e. NABCONS to IA.
9. Priority should have to be given to (i) 60 Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected, tribal and Backward Districts of 9 states, and (ii) Bundelkhand region of UP & MP for covering beneficiaries under each project in consultation with the State Governments. The details of Districts to be covered for beneficiary selection will be finalized in view of the above and furnished by the Implementing Agency through the Coordinating Agency.
